

ORDINANCE A-643

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 8-3-1 IN THE VILLAGE OF SOMERSET, WISCONSIN

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF SOMERSET, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AND AMEND AS FOLLOWS:

TITLE 8 CHAPTER 3 SECTION 8-3-1 (a-c) Refuse Collection and Recycling (Charges and Billing)

- (a) *All Occupied Single and Two to Four Residences.* The Village of Somerset will contract with a refuse hauler to have refuse and recyclables picked up once a week from single and two to four residences.
- (b) *Charges.* The **base** monthly charge for the refuse and recycling pick up includes an administrative charge of fifty cents (\$0.50) above the contract. **If additional solid waste carts are requested the charge for an additional cart would be added to the base charge. The base rate charge is determined by the largest cart size. Changing of solid waste carts is allowed one time per calendar year. If more than one solid waste cart change is requested in a year a service fee of \$25.00 will be charged. The charge will be as follows:**

(1) Individual household fees will be volume based as follows:	
Base Rate - 32 gallons or under per pickup cart:	\$13.50 15.50 per month
Base Rate - 64 gallons or under per pickup cart:	\$15.50 17.50 per month
Base Rate - 96 gallons or under per pickup cart:	\$17.50 19.50 per month
Additional Solid Waste Cart – 32 gallon	\$11.00
Additional Solid Waste Cart – 64 gallon	\$13.00
Additional Solid Waste Cart – 96 gallon	\$15.00
(2) Duplex:	\$28.40 per month
(3) Three Unit:	\$42.30 \$51.50 per month
(4) Four Unit:	\$56.20 \$68.50 per month
(5) The contractor must be contacted for all extra pickups (furniture, construction, material, etc.)	
(6) The contractor will bill and collect directly from the customer for extra pickups (furniture, etc.).	
(7) The Village will bill for extra garbage pickup when mutually agreed to by Village and contractor.	
(8) Contractor will handle resident refuse collection questions and complaints.	

(c) *Billings.* All billings for refuse and recyclable pick up shall be monthly and become due and payable upon issuance following the period for which service is rendered. A late payment charge of three percent (3%) but not less than fifty cents (\$0.50) will be added to bills not paid within twenty (20) days of issuance. A failure to receive a bill shall not excuse nonpayment. Refuse and recycling charges shall be a lien on the property served in accordance with Sec. 66.0407, Wis. Stats.
